

Golden Valley Pilgrimage

The Golden Valley pilgrim way is a recently created pilgrimage route starting and ending at Hereford Cathedral and making a loop westward through beautiful Herefordshire countryside including the valley of the River Wye and the Golden Valley. The route links churches in the Abbeydore Deanery. A week or so ago, twenty pilgrims, most, but not all, from our own congregation, completed this route walking 42 miles over five days and visiting several delightful churches along the way.

We have been organising pilgrimages from St Michael's now for several years, alternating between local routes visiting local churches, and residential trips further afield. For this year's trip we self-catered in a converted farmhouse and buildings near Vowchurch in the Golden Valley itself, with views to the Black Hill and Hay Bluff.

For the last 20 minutes of each day's walking, we walked in silence to find the peace of the countryside and hear just the breeze in the trees and sounds of nature and prepare ourselves for a brief reflection in the final church of the day. The weather was perfect and the whole experience was most companionable.


The Indian Banquet is back; a feast of South Indian cuisine prepared by our Indian community to raise money for the Building Fund.
