**genocide** Evil Flourishes... There will be an exhibition in the Savage Chapel during the week commencing 11<sup>th</sup> July. This exhibition will remember three significant acts of genocide which took place in the last 100 years and will mark other genocides which took place over that period. Genocide is "the deliberate killing of a large group of people, especially those of a particular nation or ethnic group". The exhibition will focus on the Armenian genocide which started in 1915, the German holocaust and the Srebrenica genocide of 1995. The exhibition is put on by the Macclesfield Interfaith Group and is a reminder that people of all faiths, including Christians, have suffered through genocides in the past 100 years and are still suffering today. Please take some time to look, pray and reflect.
