Visit from Daughter of Thomas Clarke, Vicar & Archdeacon of Macclesfield

My family first came to St. Michael's in 1953, living in the vicarage on Fence Avenue. Later, both my brother Paul and I attended school in that vicarage, by then Macclesfield Preparatory School.

My father served as Vicar and later as Archdeacon, remaining devoted to St. Michael's despite many responsibilities. He died young, at 57, and his ashes rest in the chancel here (in the stone above us) at St Michael's Church.

It's been lovely to revisit these memories and share a little of our family story with St. Michael's once again.

While looking around, I also discovered the 2nd Macclesfield Guide flag in the Leigh Chapel (possibly the same pole I carried though no doubt a newer flag!)


The Indian Banquet is back; a feast of South Indian cuisine prepared by our Indian community to raise money for the Building Fund.






10 Years of Village Rwanda
