Eco-tip

Have you considered changing your broadband provider ? If not, why not? The magazine Ethical Consumer recently reviewed all providers in categories including climate impact (how they

source their energy), working conditions for employees, tax conduct (including any attempts to avoid paying tax) and company ethos. They also looked at price and internet speeds. Best buys were GreenNet, GreenISP - both are not-for-profit providers with a central focus on the environment - and Your Co-op which is owned by Mid counties, a large insurer cooperative.

Most of the big providers, like BT, Three and Vodafone, all performed badly on 3 of the 4 categories. For more details go to www.ethicalconsumer.org
