Eat seasonal foods.

At the moment many gardeners and allotment-holders have a glut of runner beans and will be delighted to share them with you. Fresh, young runner beans are a gem amongst the many wonderful



vegetables available during the British summer. At their best they are at once tender, succulent and bursting with flavour. There can be few better ways of serving runner beans than piled onto a plate alongside meltingly soft roast lamb, roast potatoes and gravy, with a good glass of claret or perhaps a Coonawarra cabernet sauvignon to wash it all down. 
