







Thank you so much to all those people who came to join in with the Children's activities during the Summer Sundays. It was so lovely to take part in a joint activity with children and adults.

Now that the September term has started we are back to the usual routine, which I will explain below.

There are activities provided for children and young people during every service now mostly involving them going out of the main service and only staying in on special occasions.





Storytelling for the younger ones, except on the (2)second Sunday of each month when we join together in the Youth Centre.

As you can imagine, we have rotas for everything!!

Would you be willing to go on a rota as a supporting adult? We require two named responsible adults for every group of children.

The opportunities are as follows:

The Angel at my Table café will be open for light refreshments.


Entry is free but donations are invited for the East Cheshire Hospice and St Michael's Church, jointly.

A 3-course meal using surplus food,


with guests contributing on a 'pay-as-you-feel' basis (a price is suggested) .
