### Building Work

At last the long-awaited work on the "Waterproofing Project" is going to start. You will see scaffolding start to go up on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> September; it will be around the south side of the tower to enable the tower roof to be replaced. Other work will be



renewing part of the guttering on the Savage Chapel roof, and remodelling and renewing gutters and rainwater chutes on the north aisle and above the south porch. The damp patches in those areas will then dry out and the stonework will not deteriorate any further. More details of the work, and how it is being funded, can be found on the noticeboard in the north aisle, or ask a member of the Building Team.

The work may take up to 12 weeks. If you are around while the guys are working I am sure you will welcome them!

..and just to be clear: this project is not to repair the main (nave) roof, though we hope that a few more temporary patches can reduce the drips for a while. Repairing the main roof will be part of an urgent major project that will take 3-4 years to bring to fruition - and for that to happen we need people to get involved...soon.

### Cheshire Streetwise **Needs Used Plastic Carrier Bags**


The food scheme at Cheshire Streetwise is in need of plastic carrier bags to hold food that they give out to people in the community.

to David Mayers). And at 4.00pm there s a prayer service in the rewilded garden behind Macclesfield Leisure Centre.






